



# CATHOLICS AND MORALITY

This Winter, through the *Catechetical Institute* of the Diocese of Raleigh, St. Andrew’s Adult Faith Formation is offering you an opportunity to deepen your knowledge and appreciation of Christian morality. Those who attend and engage in at least five of the six sessions will earn a Certificate of Participation from the Diocese of Raleigh, applicable toward Basic Catechist Certification.

## Christian Morality: Life in Christ

### Course Overview:

Moral theology is much more than a simple consideration of right and wrong. This course will help participants to grasp the foundations of moral principles and convictions in the Roman Catholic tradition. It will address how our behavior is a response to God and our relationships in the human community. The nature of sin, law, grace and virtue will be explored. Integral to each session is prayer, course content, faith sharing, and large/small group discussion so that participants can apply the teachings to their life and ministry. Ability to engage in respectful dialog with fellow adults is presumed.
